## 2021-22 Academic Year – IN PROCESS

### Key Guidance:

- Funds Disburse Directly to Students
- Open to All Students; But Prioritize Undergraduate Students
- Prioritize Students with Greatest Demonstrated Need
- Leveraging Funds for Entering Student Not Permissible
- Begin Awarding in Summer 2021; Fully Expend Funds by May 2022
- Max Recommended Award: Set at maximum Federal Pell award, \$6,495
